Description The intern has been mainly involved in the statistical analysis of some databases, concerning two main projects:

- *New policies and institutions to escape the fate of recurring crises*, RAstaNEWS, 1st Annual Report. The attention has been paid on the economic condition of the major european countries. In particular the main analysis concerned the "German Hartz Structural Reforms" and their effects on unemployment, observing how the salary changed, how the incentive to work raised, and especially how was possible for the public sector to go into deficit and after to restore it. Then, the German experience has been compared with the one of France, Ireland, Portugal and Greece. This report has been presented in Brussel by *Bruegel think tank* on 4th June 2015. - Stylized business cycle facts: assessing the empirical performance of the macroeconomics ABM in *Emergent Dynamics of a Macroeconomic agent Based Model with Capital and Credit*, (Assenza-Delli Gatti-Grazzini, 2015). Using the artificial time series generated by the ABM the main interests concerned the possibility: (i) to gather and assemble the macroeconomic data on the US and other economies; (ii) to retrieve the stylized facts from both the artificial and the actual time series; (iii) find a suitable strategy for the comparison of the two sets of stylized facts and suggest ways to improve the performance of the ABM by inserting labour market frictions and studying the public balance dynamics. Those suggestions took place during the conference on Complexity and Economics in Amsterdam, organized by the Tinbergen Institute (17th–20th May 2015), attended by me and my supervisor.
